2019 PTA Convention Scholarship Application

Twenty-Fourth District PTA will award up to four (4) individual scholarships designed to assist emerging PTA leaders in attending the 2019 California State PTA Convention in Monterey, CA from May 16-18, 2019. **A maximum of \$250 per person will be awarded as a reimbursement after receipts are submitted with an expense form and convention report.** Receipts, expense forms and convention reports must be received no later than May 28, 2019 (late submission will disqualify reimbursement). The \$250 maximum award may be used for convention registration, hotel costs, food, and transportation. Scholarship recipients need not attend all days of convention and funds may be used towards one-day registration. Scholarship recipients will be announced at our Spotlight on PTA Dinner and Annual Meeting on March 21, 2019.
